Fees include \$.50 recording for the first entry of each dog. \$3.00 service fee for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the dog. Entries open at 12 AM January 10, 2024 and entries close at 5 PM on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 unless the numerical limit is reached prior to this date. 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Entries will not be accepted if received without signatures, fees and back of entry form with agreement. An official AKC entry form must be used. Photocopies of front and back will be accepted if legible. No entry will be accepted which is made subject to conditions. Exhibitors whose checks are returned for NSF will be subject to all bank fees and a \$5.00 handling fee.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of GRKC, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs need be present only for their scheduled time of judging and may be excused immediately after judging unless required for further judging. Dogs will be judged in catalog order, to the extent that it is practical without holding up judging in another ring. Judges are not required to wait for dogs and it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to have his/her dog ready at ringside without waiting to be called.

Bitches who come in season after the closing date will have the entry fee less \$5.00 refunded. Notification must be received by the trial secretary before 8:30 a.m. (CST), Saturday March 23, 2024 & Sunday March 24, 2024.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which maybe alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

### INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels(King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
